VI TOXICITY DATA

Primary Route of (Entry) Exposure:

Inhalation: Inhalation of spray mists may cause irritation to nose and throat.

VII FIRST AID

Skin: Rinse skin with water. If irritation persists, contact a physician.

Ingestion: **DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING.** If victim is conscious, rinse mouth and give 1-2 glasses of water. Consult a physician immediately. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

VIII PREVENTATIVE MEASURES
