### **TORLYS** smart floors

# TORLYS LEATHER TILE

### PART 1 – MATERIALS

- .1 Pre-finished Leather tile flooring, consisting of a top wear layer of 2.2 millimetre thick Recycled Leather, a NAF (Non-added Formaldehyde) High Density Fiberboard core, and an underlayment grade agglomerated Cork backing with Microban<sup>®</sup> treatment.
- .2 TORLYS Leather Tile flooring shall be:
  - .1 Size: 15-5/16" x 15-5/16" (nominal) 388mm x 388mm
  - .2 Total Thickness: 3/8 " (nominal) 10.5mm
  - .3 *Type of Finishing*: Water-based Polyurethane Lacquer
  - .4 Edge Type: Bevelled
  - .5 Type of Decorative Top Layer. Recycled Leather
  - .6 *Type of Core*: NAF (Non-added Formaldehyde) High Density Fiberboard >850kg/M3
  - .7 *Type of Backing*: Underlayment-grade agglomerated cork with Microban<sup>®</sup> treatment.
  - .8 Assembly System: UNICLIC Glueless
  - .9 *Colours*: As selected by the Architect
  - .10 Type of Installation: Floating
- .3 Accessories:
  - .1 TORLYS mouldings: As recommended by the Manufacturer
  - .2 Colours: As selected by the Architect

#### PART 2 – PACKAGING INFORMATION

- .1 Pieces per carton: 11
- .2 Square Meters / Square feet per carton: 1.656 m2 / 17.82 Sq. ft.
- .3 Weight per Carton: 14.6 Kg / 32.2 Lbs

#### PART 3 – EXECUTION

- 3.1 Site Verification of Conditions and Preparation:
  - .1 Ensure sub-floors are clean, firm, flat (within 3/16" / 4.8mm in 10 ft / 3m), dry (less than 3% moisture on concrete, 10% or less on plywood) and smooth. TORLYS Leather Tile floors can be installed above, on or below grade, over any solid and stable sub-floor, including plywood, chipboard, old noncreaking flooring boards, hardwood flooring, concrete slabs, PVC and most ceramic tile (except heavily embossed tile).

- .2 Remove all existing carpet, baseboards, quarter-rounds and thresholds. Undercut door jams using a piece of flooring material as guide.
- .3 Repair all defects on sub-floor.
- .4 Ensure all doors can still open and close after installing the floor (minimum 3/8" / 10 mm clearance). The doorframes may need to be adapted.
- .5 Make sure all doors and windows are in place and that the room were TORLYS Leather Tile is to be installed is at an approximate temperature of 15° to 21°C (60° to 70° F) and relative humidity of 40 60%.
- 3.2 Installation
  - .1 The TORLYS Leather Tile has a built-in cork backing and does not require any additional type of underlayment, foam or other. When using TORLYS Leather Tile over concrete sub-floors, first cover the sub-floor with 0.15mm/6 mil underlayment grade poly, overlap edges by 12" / 30cm, damp-proof tape the joints and run poly up 4" / 10cm on each wall.
  - .2 Install tiles according to manufacturer's instructions. Expansion wedges must be used on walls to allow for proper expansion space (3/8" / 10mm). Areas over 30' / 10m long or wide will require and expansion moulding.
  - .3 Expansion space may be covered by a moulding, which is not fixed to the floor, but to the wall.
  - .4 If a vapour barrier has been used, attach the baseboard through the plastic membrane sticking up from the floor, using finishing nails.
- 3.3 Cleaning and Sealing
  - .1 Clean the floor by sweeping or vacuuming, or use TORLYS Floor Cleaner.
  - .2 In bathrooms fill the expansion gap with silicone sealant.
